- 1 The charity will reclaim 25p of tax on every pound you give on or after 6 April 2008.
- 2 The Government will pay to the charity an additional 3p on every pound you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for the charity does not affect your personal tax position.

If you pay income tax at the higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you. This relief is given to you by increasing your lower rate (20%) band by the grossed-up amount of all your Gift Aid donations in the year. For instance, if you made Gift Aid donations of £1,000 in the year, your lower rate band would be increased by £1,250, so that a further £1,250 of your income would be assessed at 20% rather than 40%.
